

# Addendum 1: Privacy Policy

*This Privacy Policy applies to: SurveyScope (the "Website")*

*Updated: 15 October 2025*

Your privacy is of the utmost importance for WildEye Conservation, who are responsible for the Website.

This Privacy Policy outlines:

- the way your personal information is collected and processed. "Personal information" means any information that could identify you, such as your name, your mailing address, your email address, your location and your IP address. "Personal information" is a synonym for "personal data" within the meaning of the Regulation 2016/679 of European Union (General Data Protection Regulation);
- your rights regarding your personal information;
- who is responsible for the processing of the collected and processed information;
- to whom the information is transmitted;
- the Website's policy regarding cookies.

## Changes or Modifications

We may change, modify, add or remove portions of these Terms as well as Site functionality and Services, at any time. Such revised Terms will be effective when posted publicly. You should revisit these Terms on a regular basis, as revised versions will be binding upon you. In the event we make a material change to these Terms, we may contact you via electronic mail or post a notice on the homepage to let you know of such changes. You understand and agree that your continued access to or use of this Site after the effective date of changes to these Terms indicates your acceptance of such revisions.

## 1. Collection of Personal Information

Your personal information is collected through the following methods:

- Website account registration form

We use the collected data for the following purposes:

- Contact

### **3. Cookies and Log Files**

We collect information through log files and cookies. This allow us to process statistics and information on Website traffic, to ease navigation and improve your experience.

Under the General Data Protection Regulation (European Regulation 2016/679), the use of cookies and log files that involves personal information saving and analysis requires your consent. ### **5. Storage Period of Personal Information**

The Controller will keep in its computer systems, in reasonable security conditions, the entirety of the personal information collected for the duration of the period of retention of the images submitted by you, or the lifetime of your Account, whichever comes last.

### **6. Controller**

The "Controller" is in charge of determining the purposes for which personal information is processed and the means of such processing.

## **8. Right of Objection and Withdrawal**

You have the right to object to the processing of your personal information by the website ("right to object"). ## **9. Right of Access, Rectification and Removal**

## **10. General Principles Relating to the Collection and Processing of Personal Data Under European Regulation 2016/679**

In accordance with the provisions of Article 5 of European Regulation 2016/679, the collection and processing of your personal data comply with the following principles:

- Lawfulness, fairness and transparency: your personal data may only be collected and processed with your consent. Every time your personal data is collected, you will be informed as such, along with the reasons why it is being collected;

- Limited purposes: the data is collected and processed only for purposes set out in this Privacy Policy;
- Data minimisation: only the necessary personal data for its purpose will be collected;
- Storage limited in time: personal data is stored for the duration of the period in which the images submitted by you are retained by the Website, and/or the lifetime of your Account, whichever comes last;
- Integrity and confidentiality of collected and processed personal data: the Controller is committed to maintain the integrity and confidentiality of the collected personal data.

In order to be lawful and to comply with Article 6 or European Regulation 2016/679, collection and processing will only occur if one of the following applies:

- You have given your express consent;
- Processing is necessary for the performance of a contract;
- Processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation;
- Processing is necessary in order to protect your vital interests or those of another physical person;
- Processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority;
- Processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Controller or a third party.

## **11. Additional Rights Pursuant to European Regulation 2016/679**

In accordance with European regulation relating to the processing of personal data, you also have the rights listed below. In order for the Controller to grant your request, you must provide your account username, your email address, and if relevant, your personal account or membership number. The Controller must answer your request within a period of thirty (30) days.

### **a) Right of not being the object of a decision based only on automated processing**

In accordance with the provisions of the European Regulation 2016/679, you have the right of not being the subject of a decision based solely on automated processing if the decision produces legal impact concerning you or significantly affects you.

### **b) Right to submit a complaint to the competent authority**

In the event that the Controller does not answer your request, and you wish to challenge his or her decision, or you believe one of your rights has been infringed upon, you have the right to submit a complaint to the competent authority.

## **12. Security**

Personal information we collect is stored in a secured environment. People working for us are obligated to respect the confidentiality of your personal information. To ensure the security of your personal information, we use the following methods:

- SSL (Security Sockets Layer) Protocol
- Access management - person authorized
- Access management - person concerned
- Automatic backup
- Digital certificate
- Username/password

We are committed to maintaining a high degree of confidentiality by integrating the latest technological innovations that allow us to ensure the confidentiality of your transactions. Nevertheless, no mechanism can ensure a complete security and transmitting personal information on the Internet always entails an element of risk.

## **13. Personal Data of Minors Under European Regulation 2016/679**

In accordance with the provisions of Article 8 of Regulation 2016/679, only minors over 15 years of age may consent to the processing of their personal data. If you are a minor under the age of 15, the consent of a legal representative is required in order for your personal data to be collected and processed. We reserve the right to verify by any means that you are over 15 years of age or that you have obtained the consent of a legal representative before using our Website.
